

Don Mahon	<p>Don Mahon is a former primary teacher, school principal and Department of Education inspector. He began his teaching career in the mid-1970s in a school in a disadvantaged area in the Northside of Dublin before transferring to a special school where worked as a class teacher, and subsequently as school principal. He joined the inspectorate of the Department of Education and Science in 1998, and was appointed assistant chief inspector in 2008. His responsibilities within the Inspectorate included evaluation of mainstream and special schools, and policy advice in relation to special education provision. He acted as representative board member of Ireland for the European Agency for Special Needs and Inclusive Education, and had overall management responsibility for the visiting teacher service for children with hearing and visual impairment.</p> <p>Don served previously as a member of the NCSE Council from 2009 to 2012.
