



SECONDMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR TEACHERS NCSE SUPPORT SERVICE

DEVELOPING SCHOOLS' CAPACITY TO INCLUDE STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

From March 2017, the NCSE has responsibility for

- providing Continual Professional Development (CPD) and support for teachers in the area of special educational needs (SEN) to enhance the quality of learning and teaching in relation to SEN provision (formerly provided through the SESS)
- providing support and expertise to partner schools on issues related to behaviour (formerly provided through the NBSS)
- supporting the introduction of the new model of resource teaching allocation to schools and to develop capacity to meet the needs of students with SEN.

A number of full-time seconded positions at Assistant National Coordinator and Advisor levels are required by the NCSE (working in association with Cork Education Support Centre and Navan Education Centre) to support the work of this service for 2017/18 school year.

All applicants must be qualified, serving teachers/ deputy principals/principals, fully registered with the Teaching Council and must currently hold a post in a recognised primary or post-primary school or be on secondment from such a position.
