### **Visiting Teacher Service for Children who are Deaf/Hard of Hearing**

The National Council for Special Education (NCSE) seeks applications from suitably qualified teachers to work as a visiting teacher for children who are Deaf/Hard of Hearing. The appointments are on a fixed-term (temporary) basis, for one year.

The posts may be filled by secondment.

Each contract will provide for a three-month probationary period.
