

Baking: Digital and Printable Resources

ACCESSIBLE CHEF

The website www.accessiblechef.com was created as a way to teach cooking skills to people with intellectual disabilities. Today life skills teachers, therapists, and other disability advocates and self-advocates are still using the resources.

This free resource has a huge bank of visual recipes. Visual recipes make use of task analysis, which is an evidence-based approach for breaking down a complex task into manageable steps. Each task is separated into discrete skills, and individuals can learn to complete skills in a specific order to learn new tasks. Students may require visual, physical, or verbal prompts to complete each skill, and prompts may be gradually removed as the individual becomes more independent. Visual recipes share some similarities with PECS (Picture Exchange Communication System) and curricula created with Boardmaker.

Accessible Chef is a collection of resources to teach basic cooking skills to individuals with disabilities. From *How to make Ice Water* to *No bake cookies!* Other visual recipes available include:

- Homemade Playdough
- Dirt cups
- Frozen fruit pops
- Pancakes
- Trail Mix
- Sugar Cookie Fruit Pizza
- Marshmallow Snowmen

One example: Homemade Playdough

The visual recipe for homemade Playdough (https://accessiblechef.com/recipes/homemade-playdough/) has individual visual representations for each of the following:

Step one: stir, flour, salt, cream of tartar and in a large pot.

Step two: <u>add water</u>, <u>oil</u>, <u>stir together</u>

Step three: cook, on medium heat, stirring constantly
