

Ice Painting

Ice painting is a fun activity for summer time that can be done outside to minimise cleaning up.

Items needed			
			
Water	Baking pan (any size or shape will do!)	Paint and paintbrushes	Freezer

Method:

1. Fill the baking pan halfway with water.
2. Carefully transfer the pan to a shelf/drawer where it can lay flat to freeze.
3. Allow the water to freeze for 3-4 hours or overnight.
4. When you're ready to paint, remove the pan from the freezer and run the **BOTTOM** of it under warm water to release the ice. Hold your hand on the ice so it doesn't drop into the sink and break!
5. Bring the ice outside and either place it on the ground or into a tray.
6. Paint your picture. Notice how, as the ice melts, the paint colours run into one another and make new colours. Does it change the picture? Does it make any new colour that you really like?
