

How to Draw a Cartoon Frog

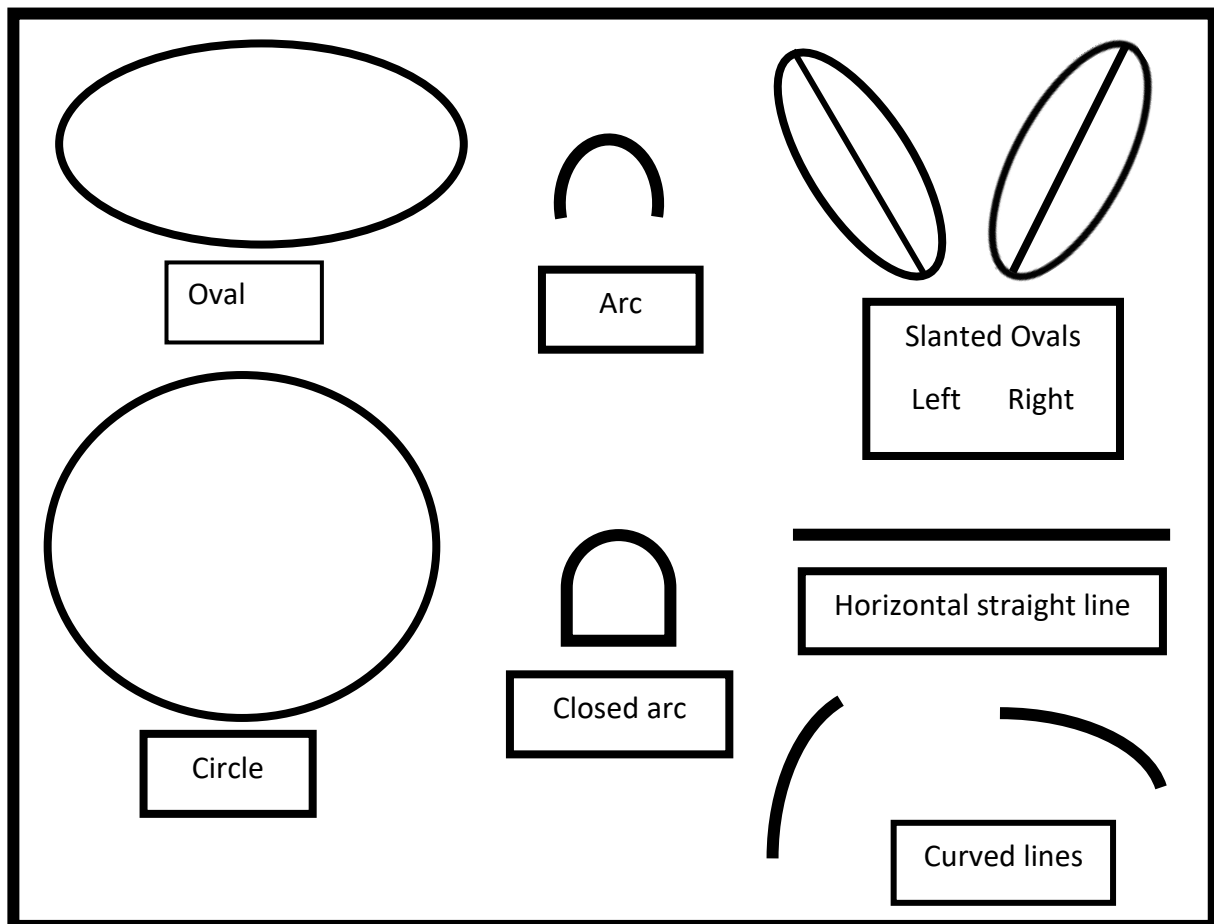
A resource for teachers within the 'Spring' theme for learning.

A fun step by step drawing activity for 3rd-6th class that develops vocabulary, listening and attention skills, ability to following directions and builds student's confidence.

HOW TO USE THIS RESOURCE

1. As you guide students through the warm up and drawing activity, model/ teach any new vocabulary, prepositions, adjectives etc. as you draw and ask students to copy. (Some suggestions are **bolded** in the directions below)
2. Begin with a warm up drawing activity below.

WARM UP DRAWING ACTIVITY- COPY THESE LINES AND SHAPES!



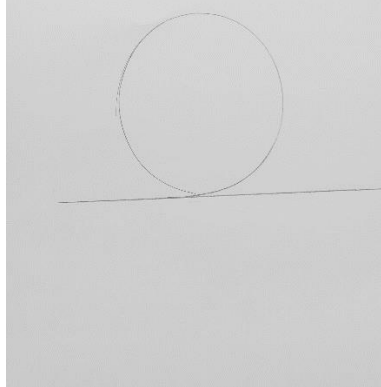
3. **GUIDED DRAWING** : Select approach A or B (below) that suits your students best :

HOW TO DRAW A CARTOON FROG

You will need: Pencil, Paper, Rubber, Colours

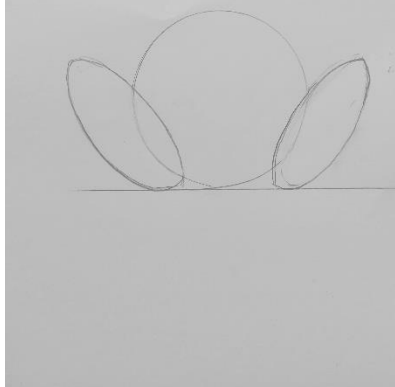


Draw a **horizontal, straight line**.

Draw a large **circle** sitting on top of the line.

This is the frog's body!

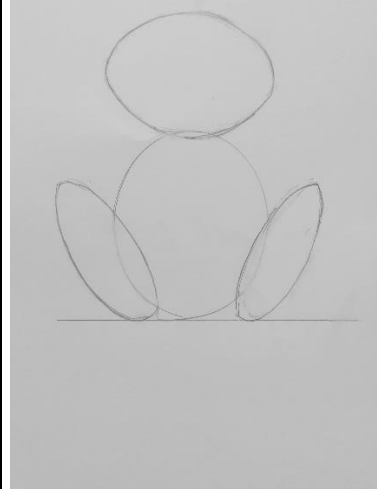
Draw a **slanted oval** sitting on the line and touching the edge of the circle on each side of the circle.

On the **left** put a slanted oval pointing left.

On the **right** put a slanted oval pointing right.

These are the frog's legs!






Draw a **medium** sized oval, lying on its side **on top of** the circle.

It should be a bit **wider** than the circle.

This is the frog's face!

<p>At the top of the oval, draw two arcs, leave a finger space between them</p> <p>Then draw a closed arc inside each of the bigger arcs.</p> <p>At the bottom right hand corner of the closed arcs draw a black circle.</p> <p>These are the frog's eyes!</p>	<p>Draw a curved lines to draw a smile on the frog's face.</p> <p>Draw a small upside down closed arc to draw a tongue.</p> <p>Draw a curved line to join the frogs face to the edge of the frog's legs.</p>	<p>Draw two small circles for his nose.</p> <p>Draw a curved line from the frog's legs to the straight line to make his back feet.</p> <p>Then draw two triangle shapes below the horizonatal line.</p>
<p>7</p> 	<p>8</p> 	<p>WHAT DO YOU LIKE BEST ABOUT YOUR FROG?</p>
<p>Using a black marker or pencil trace along the outline of the frog.</p> <p>Draw on some details such as spots, or marks on the frog's feet.</p> <p>Using a rubber, rub out any pencil marks.</p>	<p>Colour and decorate your cartoon frog however you like!</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Try create your own army of frogs! • Can you show someone at home how to draw a cartoon frog?
